Subject: Clarification regarding Response Time – Tender No. DMITEQP-ITB-108

With reference to your letter dated 16 January 2026 regarding the alleged violation of PPRA Rule-13 (Response Time) in respect of the subject-cited tender, it is respectfully submitted that the Procuring Agency identified an inadvertent clerical error in the originally published bid submission/opening date immediately after publication of the advertisement.

In order to ensure full compliance with the applicable provisions of PPRA Rules, 2004, and well before the originally scheduled bid opening, a corrigendum was issued & published in national dailies -**the New & Express**- through PID vide PID No. 5778/25 (Copy attached), on **14th of January 2026**, whereby the bid submission date was extended to Thursday, 29 January 2026 @ 10:00 AM.

It is further submitted that, in accordance with Rule-13 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004, the response time for receipt of bids is to be reckoned from the date of publication of the advertisement or notice, and under no circumstances shall it be less than **fifteen (15) days** for national competitive bidding. As a result of the aforesaid corrigendum, the effective response time available to prospective bidders from the date of corrigendum published in national dailies (14 January 2026) to the revised bid submission last date (29 January 2026) stands at sixteen (16) days, which is in full conformity with the minimum response time prescribed under PPRA Rule-13.

It is further clarified that no bids were opened prior to the revised date, and the timely corrective action ensured transparency, fair competition, and strict adherence to the PPRA Rules, 2004.

For ease of reference and verification, copy of the corrigendum, and proof of publication are enclosed herewith for your kind information and record.

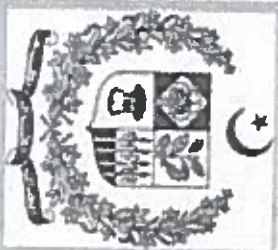

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your tender notice appeared in Daily 'Express' Newspaper on 14 January, 2026. The said advertisement is in violation of Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) Rules 2004, Rule No. 13 'Response Time'.

In the tender notice, the submission and opening date of bid is given on 26-01-2026, where it does not fulfill the fifteen days of response time, and is two (02) days less. It is a violation of Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) Rules 2004, Rule 13. The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

13. Response time.- (1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen *days for national competitive bidding and thirty ***days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.**

Project Director, Prime Minister National Project for Prevention & Control of Diabetes, Islamabad is requested to rectify the given mistake and issue corrigendum in accordance with Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) Rules 2004 to avoid mis-procurement under Rule 50.
