**Subject: Complaint Against Allegations of Technical Issue in ePPS and Non-Display of  
Eligibility Documents of Communication, Works, Physical Planning & Housing (CWPP&H)  
Department, Balochistan Tenders**

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint against allegations of technical issue in Electronic Public Procurement System (ePPS) and non-display of eligibility documents of communication, works, physical planning & housing (CWPP&H) Department, Balochistan tenders **(Annex-A)**.

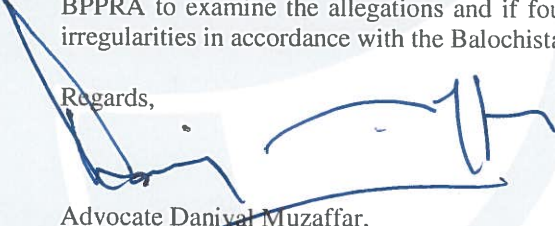
The complainant has made the following allegations:

1. The Office of the Executive Engineer (Roads), CWPP&H Department, District Kachhi at Dhadar invited tenders for various construction works vide Tender No. TSE 2627071123623, TSE 2627071123613, TSE 2627071123603, TSE 2627071123573, and TSE 2627071123643.
2. The complainant M/s Haji Mehrullah & Company submitted its bid through the e-bidding ePPS and its electronic bids were successfully accepted by the system with all the required eligibility documents and attachments.
3. However, as per the ePPS mechanism, the electronic bid could not be finalized/submitted without completion of mandatory fields and uploading of the required documents and attachments.
4. During the evaluation process, the eligibility documents/attachments uploaded by the firm were not displayed on the Procuring Agency's ePPS dashboard due to a technical issue in the system.
5. Despite the technical issue, the Procuring Agency proceeded with the evaluation process without verifying the ePPS system record or confirming whether the required documents had been successfully uploaded by the firm.
6. The Procuring Agency subsequently declared M/s Haji Mehrullah & Company ineligible in the subject tenders on the basis of the non-availability/non-display of the required eligibility documents.
7. The firm was declared ineligible without adequately examining the technical issue or verifying the submitted documents with the concerned BPPRA/EPPS authorities, despite fulfilling the applicable eligibility requirements, thereby depriving it of a fair and transparent evaluation of its bids.

**Transparency International Pakistan Comments and Recommendations**

Transparency International Pakistan has reviewed the allegations of the complaint and requests the MD BPPRA to examine the allegations and if found correct, direct the Procuring Agency to address the irregularities in accordance with the Balochistan Public Procurement Rules 2014.

**Note:**

This is to clarify that Transparency International Pakistan is not a complainant, it acts as a whistleblower and operate under Article 19-A, of the Constitution of Pakistan which gives the right to public to know how government is being run by public officers. Article 19-A makes the right to access of information pertaining to a public authority a fundamental right, and a three-member bench in case of Mukhtar Ahmad Ali vs the Registrar, Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad, headed by Chief Justice Qazi Faez Isa in the landmark judgment on 16 October 2023, in CP No. 3532/2023, has declared that

“What previously may have been on a need-to-know basis Article 19A of the Constitution has transformed it to a right-to-know, and the Access to information is no longer a discretion granted through occasional benevolence, but is now a fundamental right available with every Pakistani which right may be invoked under Article 19A of the Constitution”

**Subject: COMPLAINT AGAINST BPPRA OF TECHNICAL ISSUE IN EPPS SYSTEM, NON-DISPLAY OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS AND UNJUST DECLARATION OF OUR FIRM AS INELIGIBLE (TSE-2627071123623, TSE-2627071123613, TSE-2627071123603, TSE-2627071123573 & TSE-2627071123643)**

R/Sir,

With due respect, it is respectfully submitted that **M/s Haji Mehrullah & Company** (NTN No. 4032375), a duly registered contractor with the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR), Balochistan Revenue Authority (BRA), and Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) Category C-1/2077, hereby submits this complaint against the technical issue occurred in the EPPS System and the subsequent declaration of our firm as ineligible by the Procuring Agency.

1. That our firm, **M/s Haji Mehrullah & Company** (NTN No. 4032375), participated in the following tender competitions through the e-bidding EPPS System invited by the Executive Engineer (Roads), CWPP&H Department, District Kachhi at Dhadar, as under:

2. That the EPPS System successfully accepted our electronic bids, which confirms that the bid submission process was completed successfully and all mandatory requirements for submission were fulfilled.

3. That as per the EPPS system mechanism, the bidder cannot finalize/submit the electronic bid without completing mandatory fields and uploading the required documents/attachments.

4. That during the evaluation process, due to a technical issue/glitch in the EPPS System, the uploaded eligibility documents/attachments of our firm were not displayed on the Procuring Agency's e-procurement dashboard.
5. That the non-display of uploaded documents was purely a system-related technical issue and was not due to any negligence, omission, or failure on the part of our firm.
6. That upon occurrence of such technical issue, the Procuring Agency was required to verify the matter through the concerned authorities of BPPRA/EPPS System and confirm the status of uploaded documents before making any adverse decision.
7. That instead of resolving/verifying the technical issue, the Procuring Agency issued the Eligibility/Evaluation Reports and declared our firm ineligible in the subject tenders on the ground of non-availability/non-display of eligibility attachments.
8. That the decision of the Procuring Agency was taken without proper verification of the EPPS record and without considering the technical malfunction of the system.
9. That the unilateral declaration of our firm as ineligible has caused serious prejudice and resulted in deprivation of our lawful right to participate in a fair and transparent procurement process.
10. That our firm fulfills the required registration, technical, and eligibility criteria and is entitled to fair consideration of its bids after verification of the EPPS system record and submitted documents.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the matter may kindly be examined and the above-mentioned technical issue may be resolved after verification from the EPPS system record. It is further requested that the Procuring Agency may kindly be directed to re-evaluate the above-mentioned tenders in a fair and transparent manner in the interest of justice.
