**Subject: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Executive Engineer, Maintenance-II Division, Communications and Works Department, Peshawar's Tender Notice for Establishment and Construction of Emergency Ward in Sifwat Ghayur Shaheed Memorial Hospital, Peshawar**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your tender notice appeared in Daily 'Mashriq' Newspaper on 30 May, 2026. The said advertisement is in violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Rule No. 34 'Response Time'.

In the tender notice, the submission and opening date of bid is given on 11-06-2026, where it does not fulfill the fifteen days of response time, and is two (02) days less. It is a violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Rule 34. The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

*34. Response time.---(1) The procuring entity may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals including proposals for pre-qualification from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the contract's complexity, and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice in the national newspaper.*

Executive Engineer, Maintenance-II Division, Communications and Works Department, Peshawar is requested to rectify the given mistake and issue corrigendum in accordance with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, to avoid mis-procurement under Rule 54.

**Note:**

This is to clarify that Transparency International Pakistan is not a complainant, it acts as a whistleblower and operate under Article 19-A, of the Constitution of Pakistan which gives the right to public to know how government is being run by public officers. Article 19-A makes the right to access of information pertaining to a public authority a fundamental right, and a three-member bench in case of Mukhtar Ahmad Ali vs the Registrar, Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad, headed by Chief Justice Qazi Faez Isa in the landmark judgment on 16 October 2023, in CP No. 3532/2023, has declared that

“What previously may have been on a need-to-know basis Article 19A of the Constitution has transformed it to a right-to-know, and the Access to information is no longer a discretion granted through occasional benevolence, but is now a fundamental right available with every Pakistani which right may be invoked under Article 19A of the Constitution”

**Terms and Conditions:**

1) The Bid documents including instruction to bidders may be uploaded on E-PADs on C&W website for bidder convenience but the same set of criteria bid documents in hard form should be obtained by an interested eligible bidder on submission of written application from the office of the undersigned on any working days before closing date on 11-06-2026 i.e. payment of Rs. 4000 (Non-refundable). 2) The Bid Security 2% of the Estimated Cost in the Shape of Cash Deposit (in Original) any Schedule Bank shall be kept sealed in the financial proposal shall in addition place an affidavit financial bids. 3) The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition 2% Bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly. 4) Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detail rate analysis. 5) In case of more than 20% below bid, if the bid is not accompanied by the detail rate analysis and/or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive accordingly. 6) In case detail rate analysis submitted with the bids is in view of the procuring Entity, non-compliance, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof. 7) All taxes should be deducted as per government rules and policy. 8) The Bids must be accompanied by a non-refundable Tender fee @ 0.03% of the Engineer's Estimate; in the shape of CDR otherwise bidder will be considered disqualified. 9) All the bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, FBR, should enlist with C&W Department established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXII of 2013), for works consulting and non-consulting service as listed in schedule II of Act (bid. 10) The bidders should submit their E-PADs as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (14)/Vol. 1-24/2021-22 Dated 10/05/2022. 11) The Bid who CDR is not found in financial bid then they will dealt with as per KPPRA notification S.R.O. (29) Vol.1-40/2025-26 dated 29/01/25. 12) The Opening of Financial Bid, Office of Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division, at Bacha Khan Chowk Peshawar.
