Subject: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Office of the Commandant Special Security Unit SSU, Peshawar's Tender Notice for Procurement for Contingency / Miscellaneous Items for Remodeling of Warsak Canal System, District Khyber

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your tender notice appeared in Daily 'Mashriq' Newspaper on 03 August, 2026. The said advertisement is in violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Rule No. 34 'Response Time'.

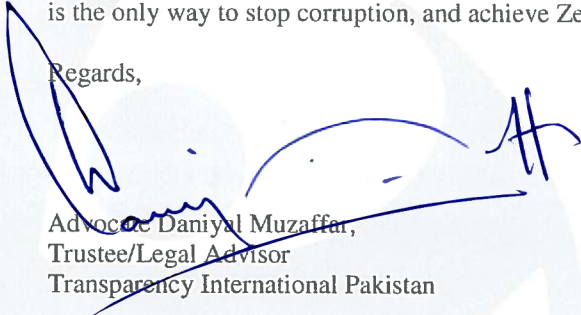
In the tender notice, the submission and opening date of bid is given on 14-08-2026, where it does not fulfill the fifteen days of response time, and is three (03) days less. It is a violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Rule 34. The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

***34. Response time.---**(1) The procuring entity may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals including proposals for pre-qualification from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the contract's complexity, and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice in the national newspaper.*

Office of the Commandant Special Security Unit SSU, Peshawar, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is requested to rectify the given mistake and issue corrigendum in accordance with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, to avoid mis-procurement under Rule 54.

Note:

This is to clarify that Transparency International Pakistan is not a complainant, it acts as a whistleblower and operate under Article 19-A, of the Constitution of Pakistan which gives the right to public to know how government is being run by public officers. Article 19-A makes the right to access of information pertaining to a public authority a fundamental right, and a three-member bench in case of Mukhtar Ahmad Ali vs the Registrar, Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad, headed by Chief Justice Qazi Faez Isa in the landmark judgment on 16 October 2023, in CP No. 3532/2023, has declared that

“What previously may have been on a need-to-know basis Article 19A of the Constitution has transformed it to a right-to-know, and the Access to information is no longer a discretion granted through occasional benevolence, but is now a fundamental right available with every Pakistani which right may be invoked under Article 19A of the Constitution”

NOTICE INVITING (e-PADS)

1. Office of the COMMANDANT SPECIAL SECURITY UNIT SSU, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works & Service Rules 2014 invites bids under National/ Competitive Bidding from manufacturers, or from their authorized distributors for Financial Year 2026-27 for the procurement of Other Contingency/Miscellaneous items for Remodeling of Warsak Canal System District Khyber. Last date for submission of proposals 14/08/2026 upto 10:00 hrs. Proposal will be opened on the same date at 11:00 hrs in the presence of Procurement Committee and bidders or their representative who choose to attend in office of the Deputy Commandant SSU. The delivery period will be 15 days or as per contract agreement.
2. The specifications/tender documents & NIT pertaining to the above-mentioned item can be obtained from the office of the Account Section SSU, 3rd floor elite building Malik Saad Shaheed Police Line Peshawar. Bidder shall submit their proposal through e-PADS and hard in original form as well to the Account Section SSU.
3. **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**
The following terms and conditions shall apply:
 - i. Only registered suppliers, who are on Active Taxpayers list (ATL) of FBR, are eligible to supply goods/services to Government departments (where applicable).
 - ii. Each firm shall submit one sealed envelope containing the Financial Proposal.
 - iii. A firm that has successfully completed three to four similar/relevant tenders with Police Deptt in previous FY year and has at least one ongoing project with police Department at the time of bidding process is eligible to apply.
 - iv. The bidders shall submit Rs. 50,000/- as security with financial proposal from the account of the firm/bidder/contractor of any scheduled bank with their proposal in favour of the DDO SPECIAL SECURITY UNIT (CPG) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. In case of non-acceptance of tenders, the bid security will be refunded after finalization of the tender.
 - v. In case of acceptance of tenders, the bidders shall deposit a security Rs. 100,000/- of the total value of stores in the form of Call Deposit in the name of the undersigned and sign the contract agreement with COMMANDANT SPECIAL SECURITY UNIT SSU Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police after completion of all legal formalities.
 - vi. Rates quoted should be considered only if the same are in Pak Rupees and inclusive of all taxes/duties/charges and inclusive of packing/freight till delivery to the project site. Rates shall be valid up to 30.06.2027.
 - vii. Conditional tender/application will not be entertained.
 - viii. All taxes will be deducted as per existing government policy.
 - ix. The procuring entity will have the right to reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of bidder's proposal. The procuring entity shall upon request communicate the grounds for rejection of bid or proposal to any contractor or consultant who submitted a bid or proposal.
 - x. The competent authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids under KPFR Rules 47(1).
