Rules, 2014, Office of the Inspector General of Police, Central Police Officer, Peshawar's
Tender Notice for Fortification / Special Repair Works at Central Police Office (CPO)
Peshawar**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your tender notice appeared in Daily 'Aaj' Newspaper on 25 March, 2026. The said advertisement is in violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Rule No. 34 'Response Time'.

In the tender notice, the submission and opening date of bid is given on 03-04-2026, where it does not fulfill the fifteen days of response time, and is five (05) days less. It is a violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, Rule 34. The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

34. Response time.--(1) The procuring entity may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals including proposals for pre-qualification from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the contract's complexity, and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice in the national newspaper.

Office of the Inspector General of Police, Central Police Officer, Peshawar is requested to rectify the given mistake and issue corrigendum in accordance with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules, 2014, to avoid mis-procurement under Rule 54.

Note:

This is to clarify that Transparency International Pakistan is not a complainant, it acts as a whistleblower and operate under Article 19-A, of the Constitution of Pakistan which gives the right to public to know how government is being run by public officers. Article 19-A makes the right to access of information pertaining to a public authority a fundamental right, and a three member bench in case of Mukhtar Ahmad Ali vs the Registrar, Supreme Court of Pakistan, Islamabad, headed by Chief Justice Qazi Faez Isa in the landmark judgment on 16 October 2023, in CP No. 3532/2023, has declared that

“What previously may have been on a need-to-know basis Article 19A of the Constitution has transformed it to a right-to-know, and the Access to information is no longer a discretion granted through occasional benevolence, but is now a fundamental right available with every Pakistani which right may be invoked under Article 19A of the Constitution”

Sub Work is:

- 1- A complete set of bids Solicited on Documents (i.e Tender form, Instruction to the Bidders, BOQ, and Criteria etc.) shall be downloaded from the official website of E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS of KPRA) at (http://epprocure.gov.pk)
2. Interested bidders must submit their Bid via E-PADS (Scan Copy) and original Bid (Hard copy) submitted in two sealed envelopes separately marked as technical and financial bids with single outer envelope which must reach the office of the undersigned through register counter office before closing time and date mentioned above.
3. The bid security in the shape of CER from any schedule bank/branches in Pakistan in the favor of DIG Finance & Procurement, Peshawar must be attached, with the technical bid and original copy be uploaded on KPRA (EPADS) and original be submitted in sealed envelope along with Technical Bid.
4. The bidders should submit "Additional Bid Security" as per KPRA Notification (Updated).
5. The bidders are required to quote rates above or below on both IARS as well as on non IARS items.
6. The bidders who are going to submit their bids through both (soft and hard) shall be declared as responsive and their bids shall not be considered for evaluation. Technical evaluation will be carried out in the office of Chairman Procurement Committee on the basis of technical evaluation criteria given in bid solicitation document.
7. Bidders are advised to carry out a site visit to obtain first hand information regarding site conditions before submitting their bid.
8. Bids received through hard fax/telephone email would not be entertained.
9. Any electronic bidders who submit fake or forged documents or information shall stand De-Barred.
10. In case of material deviation or change between the hard and soft copies of the bid, the bid shall be deemed rejected and non-responsive.
11. In case of any unforeseen reasons, public holidays, unrest or force majeure on the bid submission / opening date, the bid shall be opened on next working day at the same place and time.
12. Interested bidders can obtain any further information/ clarification from the office of SP Admin CPO Peshawar Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police.
13. The procuring entity may reject all bids at any time prior to the acceptance of a
