



Memorandum of Understanding.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed on Friday 14th December 2012 between Pakistan Telecommunication Authority (PTA) Government of Pakistan and Transparency International Pakistan (TI-P) for the Implementation of the “**Integrity Pact**”.

PTA intends to maintain complete transparency in its processes and would like to avail TI-P's expertise to adopt best practices while following the rules of the Government. Both the esteemed organizations show their commitment to work together to achieve the objectives of this MOU.

By signing this MOU, on both parties hereby agree to the following:

TIP will provide assistance to PTA gratis, which will encompass the following:

- Bring to the Knowledge of the Chairman, the anomalies in procurement along with recommendations to address them in resulting in savings to PTA.
- Ensuring tender procedure comply with Public Procurement Rules 2004;
- Tender documents are made available to all qualified interested parties;
- Formation of transparent tender evaluation criteria and vet documents ;
- Vet and 3G Auction procedures and make it transparent;
- Complaints, If any, received from the aggrieved party are addressed on merit by a grievance committee as per rules;
- PTA will ensure that TIP's observations are addressed promptly.
- TI-P under its charter will not participate in PTA tendering process in any capacity except as an observer.
