## Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed on 4 April 2013 between Printing Corporation of Pakistan and Transparency International Pakistan (TI-P) for the Implementation of the "Integrity Pact".

By signing this MOU this day both parties hereby agree to the following:

TIP will provide assistance to PCP gratis, which will encompass the following:

- Bring to the Knowledge of the Managing Director, the anomalies in procurement alongwith the recommendations to address them for resulting in savings to PCP.
- Ensuring tender procedure with Public Procurement Rules 2004;
- Tender documents are made available to all qualified interested parties;
- Formation of transparent tender evaluation criteria and vet documents;
- Vet the tender documents prior to issue to bidders, and make them transparent;
- Complaints if any received from the aggrieved party are addressed on merit by a Grievance Committee as per rules;
- PCP will ensure that TIP's observations are addressed promptly;
- TI-P under its charter will not participate in PCP tender process in any capacity except as an observer.
